## AGREEMENT

This Agreement made this day of home, 1959, by and between the Village of Monticello, the Town of Mt. Pleasant and the Town of Washington, all being in Green County, Wisconsin, in pursuance of authority of the village board and the town boards of said village and towns, respectively.

Whereas the said village and the said towns are considering building a new fire house on land to be owned in equal undivided one-thirds as tenants in common, and whereas the said village is now the owner of the hereafter described real estate and the said towns are now the owners of a 1945 FWD truck, Serial No. 112195, Motor No. 87068, and a homemade semitrailer, Serial No. T19976-Wis., and it is desired by all parties to make a change in ownership of such real estate and personal property in the event the proposed building project is entered into:

It is agreed as follows that on the date that a contract for the construction of the proposed fire house is let, the village will, in consideration of the sale to it of an undivided one-third interest in the above described truck and trailer, convey an undivided one-third of the hereafter described real estate to each of said towns.

That the real estate in which an interest is berein agreed to be conveyed is located in Green County, Wisconsin, and is described as follows, to-wit:

Outlot 39 of the Original Plat of the Village of Monticello except a piece thereof described as follows, commencing at the Northwest corner thereof, thence East 36 feet, thence South 45 feet, thence West 36 feet, thence North to the place of beginning.
