RESOLUTION 4-99

GRANT VILLAGE POWERS TO TOWN BOARD

WHEREAS

The authority of Town Boards to exercise village powers, is established in Section 60.22(3) of Wisconsin Statutes as authorized by a town meeting vote under Section 60.10(2)(c) of Wisconsin Statutes.

WHEREAS

The purpose of village powers for the Mt. Pleasant Town Board is when exercising various police powers that are more clearly established for Village Boards in Section 61.34(1). Village powers granted to the town board would give them power to act for the government in good order of the town, for its commercial benefit and for health, safety, welfare and convenience of the public.

WHEREAS

The exercise of village powers does not take away the powers of the electors under the town meeting section of the statutes nor does it change a town into a village. The Town Board may exercise powers relating to villages and conferred on Village Boards under Chapter 61, except those powers which conflict with statutes relating to towns and Town Boards.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED

at a special meeting of the electors of the Town of Mt. Pleasant, village powers be granted to the Mt. Pleasant Town Board.
