Proposed Resolution for the VACATION OF PRATT ROAD

RESOLVED, that the public interest requires that the town road known as Pratt Road in the Town of Mt Pleasant be discontinued pursuant to Wis. Stat. §66.1003 from (i) the point at which it intersects the right of way of Marshall Bluff Road to (ii) the point at which it intersects the west boundary of the bicycle trail known as the Sugar River Trail, effective October 1, 2010, provided, however, that there shall be reserved a perpetual easement equal to the width to the right of the way of said discontinued road and extending from (x) the point at which such town road intersects the right of way of Marshall Bluff Road to (y) a point fifty feet west of the intersection of the right of way of Pratt Road and the west bank of the Little Sugar River, such easement to be solely for the benefit of existing and future owners of land abutting that portion of the Pratt Road right of way over which such easement is reserved, and for the benefit of the State of Wisconsin and its instrumentalities, agents or contractors for the purpose of maintaining or removing the truss bridge that currently spans the Little Sugar River as part of Pratt Road, all as shown in the legal description and map that is Exhibit A# to this resolution.
