

TOWN OF MOUNT PLEASANT
Ordinance Establishing Special or Seasonal Weight Limits

1. The Board of Supervisors of the Town of Mount Pleasant, Green County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority to adopt this ordinance under Wis. Stat. §349.16.

2. The following special or seasonal weight limits shall be effective for the periods stated below on the following Town of Mount Pleasant town highways, which are declared to be Class B highways under Wis. Stat. §349.15(2):

(a) Wittenwyler Road, from State Route 69 to the intersection of Wittenwyler Road and Feldt Road, shall have a year round weight limit of 20 tons for any single vehicle or combination of vehicles being towed.

3. The Board of Supervisors shall cause signs to be erected as required under Wis. Stat. §349.16(2) with respect to the town highways designated as Class B highways pursuant to Section 2 hereof on or before the effective date of this ordinance or any subsequent amendment thereto that adds any additional town highways to the designation in Section 2 hereof.

4. No person may operate any vehicle on the town highways designated in Section 2 in excess of such weight limits without a written permit issued by the Board of Supervisors of the Town of Mount Pleasant. Such permits shall be issued only upon written application of the person seeking the permit, on a form to be supplied by the Board of Supervisors and made available by the Town Clerk, which shall state the name of the person seeking the permit, his or her address and telephone number, the name and address of any business for which such permit will be used, if different from the applicant, the estimated number of overweight trips to be made separately for each month in the twelve month period following the month of the application, the type or types of vehicles making the overweight trips, and a description of the cargo on the overweight trips. Permits shall be issued only for the transportation of crops or products used in agriculture. Applications for permits shall be filed not less than 60 days prior to the desired effective date of the permit. Permits may be granted or denied by the Board of Supervisors on the basis of the public health and safety and the estimated wear and tear to the town highway in question. For filing an application for a permit the applicant shall pay a fee of \$500.00 to the Town Clerk, which is nonrefundable. ~~[consider sliding fee scale based on number of overweight trips]~~ Each permit granted under this Section 4 shall be effective for twelve months or such shorter time as the Board of Supervisors shall approve.
